






Context

- Basic homicide ('killing a person...') sentencing range 10 20 years
- The legal description, as well as the sentencing framework for this offence have remained the same during 1969 today
- The sentencing was higher before 1969 (but no such case entered into the BHS analysis)
- Attempt is punished the same for all offences, meaning with a sentence reduced by half (thus, 5-10 years for homicide)






Context


- The aggravated form of murder (qualified homicide) is prescribed in a separate article with a sentencing range 15 - 25 years or life imprisonment and ban on certain rights
- Ban on certain rights can also be applied together with the main sentence.
- Privileged homicide is not regulated as such, but some forms exist in the Criminal Code (infanticide, killing on request).
- Aggravated and mittating circumstances are applicable in case of homicide
- Admission of guilt not available for qualified homicide







Homicide recorded by prosecution's offices
















Romanian data – BHS sampling











Analysis of Romanian data - offenders









Analysis of Romanian data – offenders motive









Analysis of Romanian data – modus operandi




