








It's all about perception- it shapes social reality!









### 02 Conceptual challenges

Family an axiological category that is constantly changing both functionally and structurally

**SOLUTION:** material + formal criteria

Volence expanding the multidimensional concept of violence to various subtypes of violence

SOLUTION: dichotomy: physical and psychological violence

Domestic violence strong focus on violence against women/violence between intimate partners + generational discrepancy in the perception of domestic violence

SOLUTION: Research broadening - Inclusion: violence of parents against children, violence of children against parents, violence against elders, violence between same-sex partners + A dark figure?



Decline in violence:

- Movements for human rights: women's rights, children's rights, gay rights, animal rights appeared one after the other.
- ✤ it is about a long-term historical process:
- 1. Peter Singer calls it the phenomenon of expanding compassion circle, people have become more compassionate (Singer 1981); or similar,
- 2. Payne's thesis is that in moments when people's own lives have improved and become more comfortable (they eat better, are healthier, are more comfortable), they value their own and other people's lives more (Payne 2004) or
- 3. Elias explains this change through the process of civilizing (Elias 1939)
- 4. the reduction of violence is often a product of the invisible to us, of seemingly insignificant circumstances in human history such as improvements in hygiene, the creation of manners, the use of utensils for eating or a sense of decency (Hunt 2008).







Domestic violence pandemic? Are we sure?

Mainstream research does not take into an account:

More reports (demystifying domestic abuse+raising awarness) and broadening the scope of what violence actually is.

#### Misdemeanour DVPA

Domestic violence is:

1. application of physical force that did not result in physical injury

2. corporal punishment or other forms of humiliating treatment of children

3. psychological violence that caused a violation of the victim's dignity or distress 4. sexual harassment

5. economic violence as the prohibition or impossibility of using joint or personal property, disposal of personal income or property acquired through personal work or inheritance, impossibility of employment, denial of funds for the maintenance of a joint household and for the care of children 6. neglecting the needs of a person with a disability or an elderly person, which leads to his distress or insults his dignity and thus causes him physical or mental suffering.

#### **Criminal offense CC**

Whoever seriously violates the regulations of DVPA and thereby causes a family member or close person to fear for their safety or the safety of persons close to them, or puts them in a humiliating position or a state of longterm suffering, and this has not committed a more serious crime, shall be punished by imprisonment from one to three years.



According to Croatian Law, possible qualifications:


- a) Criminal offense: Threat towards a family member (Art.139 CCC, 6 months 5 years of imprisonment)
- b) Special Criminal offense: Domestic violence (Art. 179.a CCC, 1-3 years of imprisonment)
- c) Misdemeanour: Domestic violence (Art. 10. DVPA, -90 days of imprisonment/260 euros)





Who reported domestic violence? (%)












**Domestic violence duration (%)**

long term violence










**Children witnessed domestic violence (%)** 



children not presentchildren present










**Perpetrator gender (%)** 



male female










Victim and offender – household (%)




















**Perpetrator under the influence of alcohol (%)**










**Perpetrator - employment status (%)**





Victim - marital status










#### domestic violence victims per age (N)









#### Misdemeanour DVPA

Domestic violence is:

- 1. application of physical force that did not result in physical injury

- 5. economic violence as the prohibition or impossibility of using joint or personal property, disposal of personal income or property acquired through personal work or inheritance, impossibility of employment, denial of funds for the maintenance of a joint household and for the care of children 6. neglecting the needs of a person with a disability or an elderly person, which leads to his distress or insults his dignity and thus causes him physical or mental suffering.

#### **Criminal offense CC**

Whoever seriously violates the regulations of DVPA and thereby causes a family member or close person to fear for their safety or the safety of persons close to them, or puts them in a humiliating position or a state of longterm suffering, and this has not committed a more serious crime, shall be punished by imprisonment from one to three years.



#### Dubious cases? Or not?

Examples:

Husband and wife are fighting. At one moment wife says: "I will kill you if you cheat on me again, and I mean it".

While studying math with her 9 year old son, mother says: "I cannot believe you are that lazy and stupid. You will get a bad grade and you deserved it."

Sister pushes her brother outside of her room and says: "Don't you ever come into my room again or I will destroy your laptop"

A says to his romantic partner: "You are stupid and you deserve to die"

B is the only one earning money in the house. His wife doesn't work. One day she wanted to go to the store but B refused to give her money.
